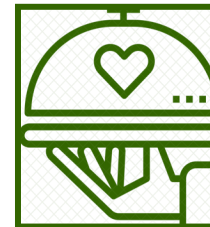

Elders' Corner:

Greetings brethren. We trust this message finds you well. We'd like to give you a quick update on a variety of issues surrounding our building. As most of you have seen, we have been experiencing problems with our furnaces. We've had to use space heaters in both the fellowship hall and the classrooms on the north end of the building. The source of these issues has been identified and should be repaired in the next few weeks. On the north end of the building, we had a leaking gas line pipe. The pipe was capped and is scheduled to be replaced beginning next Wednesday and should be completed by the following Sunday. This repair will cost roughly \$15,000. As for the fellowship hall, there was a problem sourcing a part. It has been located, ordered and should be installed by this coming Sunday. That expense should be \$1000 or less.

We are continuing to move forward with plans to replace the carpet and flooring in the fellowship hall. It appears we will need to purchase all materials initially, and install them as funds allow. Final measurements were taken this week and we hope to have final bid numbers in the next few days. We will keep you posted as we obtain more information and assess the funds we have available for this major expenditure.

Remember Ray as he prepares to leave for Ndola, Zambia next Monday. He will be helping get the new school up and running ahead of classes commencing February 13th. He will also be visiting the school in Kenya as classes start there as well. Pray for his safe travels and that the African instructors and students will have a productive and fruitful school year.

Remember that tonight we will be having our 5th Wednesday Devotional in the auditorium. Also, the Sweetheart Banquet will take place on February 9th at 6:30 pm in the fellowship hall.

Remember sister Alice Drake who requested our prayers this past Sunday. Please also keep those of our number who have been sick or had recent medical procedures in your prayers. Patrick Bryan, Gary Dalton, Marcella Wake, the Lees, John Martin, Edith Sullins, Mary Patchell, Nancy Kelley, and others all continue to recover from or struggle with health issues.
