Great news. We were able to start the new class last Thursday and we began with 15 students in Ndola, Zambia. There are still 2 young men who might be on the way. They are from a rural area of Zambia where reception is not good, so hopefully we will be able to communicate with them soon.

We also had a great Friday as classes began. We also had a bible study at someone's house where people from the local community came.

On Saturday, I was able to join in a radio program done in the Ndola area. It reaches many people in serval countries and covers a large area. Then on Sunday we had a great worship together with the brethren in Ndola at the Kaseshe church of Christ. As you can see, God is truly blessing our way.



Now I am in Livingstone and have had two great days with the students. John and Tiffany joined me today and it was very exciting to see them. I glad they are here to see and to help with this great work.

Another great blessing is that our school in Kenya began a new intake the same day we did in Ndola. They have 18 new students, which means that in the last week we have 33 new men training to be gospel preaches. Praise be to God for this great opportunity to train faithful men to be preachers and better servants of God.



Lord willing we have some busy days ahead, but I know God will prosper our way to do great things in His kingdom here in Zambia. Remember, I love you all and miss you all. Please continue to pray that God may bless us all as we are apart and doing His will wherever that opportunity arises.
