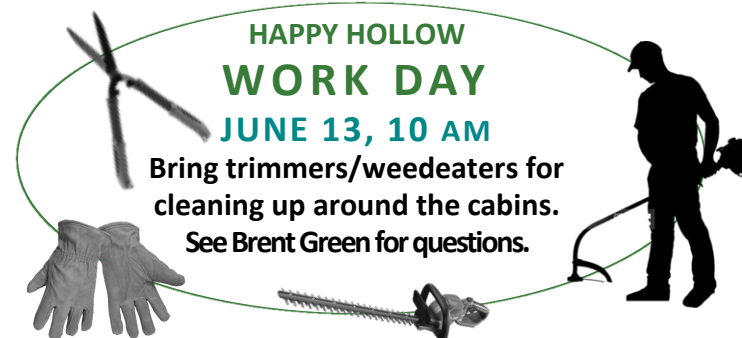

What is Righteousness?

There are many familiar words in the bible, yet we may have a difficult time defining them or explaining what they mean. The word “righteousness” may very well be one of those words. One bible app gives 586 occurrences of “righteous” or “righteousness” in the New King James Version in the Old and New Testaments combined. The first occurrence is in Genesis 7:1, where the Lord said speaking of Noah, “I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation.” According to Strong’s Lexicon, “righteous” is translated from the Hebrew word “tsad-deek” meaning one who is just in conduct and character towards God. The last time the word appears in the bible is at the close of the Revelation 22, verse 11. Speaking to John, the angel says, “He who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still.” Again, from Strong’s, the word “righteous” comes from the Greek word “dik’-ah-yos” meaning upright, virtuous, and keeping the commands of God. Thus, the word righteousness “refers to what is deemed right by the Lord after His examination and what is approved in His eyes.”

Christians are to flee from evil and “pursue righteousness.” (1 Timothy 6:11) This is a call for us to actively and enthusiastically seek God’s approval. A naysayer may refer to Romans 3:10 which states, “There is none righteous, no, not one.” And it is true that there is not a person in the world who does not sin. (Eccl. 7:20; Rom. 3:23) However, because of Jesus, the Righteous One (1 John 2:1; Rev. 16:5), we too can be righteous and seek after righteousness. “Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He (Christ) is righteous.” (1 John 3:7)

So, what is righteousness? It is the upright and moral behavior of a Christian who is actively seeking to please the Lord each and every day of this life. “For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their prayers.” (1 Peter 3:12)
